Antioch 49 A.D.

Sunday, July 12 through Thursday, July 16 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. with dinner being provided from 5:00-5:50 in our new Fellowship hall!!

Antioch 49 A.D. is a journey back in time and culture to the Apostle Paul and the early Christian Church. This Vacation Bible School ministry will be an exciting opportunity for children, youth, and adults from St. Andrew to relive Biblical events, occupations, an early House Church/Greek School, family life, culture, and the marketplace of the Gentile city of Antioch, Syria, at the time of the Apostle Paul.

Our Antioch 49 A.D. experience will be for our children age 3 through 5th grade. Infant care for our volunteers will be provided.

 - 1. We need adult volunteers to run the shops in our agora (marketplace) of Antioch, Syria:
 - House Church/Greek School, Mosaics, Tents and Awnings, Leather Goods, Produce Shop, Recreation and Olympic Games, Bakery, and Boat-Making/Fishing.

 - 4. We need volunteers to prepare dinner on Sunday through Wednesday and organize the potluck picnic on Thursday, the final night of Antioch 49 A.D.
 - 5. The props for our town are built (thanks to a wonderful group of builders!!!), but they need to be painted. Please see Michael Barbagallo if you can help with this task.
 - 6. We need music leaders and drama volunteers.
