


HS Massanetta Springs Fall Retreat

Dear Congregants of St Andrew Presbyterian Church and the Mission Committee,



Some things you DIDN'T know about the animals!

- **St. Francis Started It:** The first live nativity was staged by St. Francis of Assisi in 1223, featuring a manger, an ox, and an ass.
- **Oxen & Donkeys:** They weren't in the Bible but were added due to prophecies (Isaiah 1:3) and Christian texts, symbolizing Jews (ox) and Gentiles (donkey).
- **No Donkey Ride:** The Bible never says Mary rode a donkey; she likely walked to Bethlehem.
- **Animals Could Talk:** According to one legend, God granted all the animals in the stable the temporary gift of speech at midnight on Christmas Eve, so they could praise the newborn Christ child.
